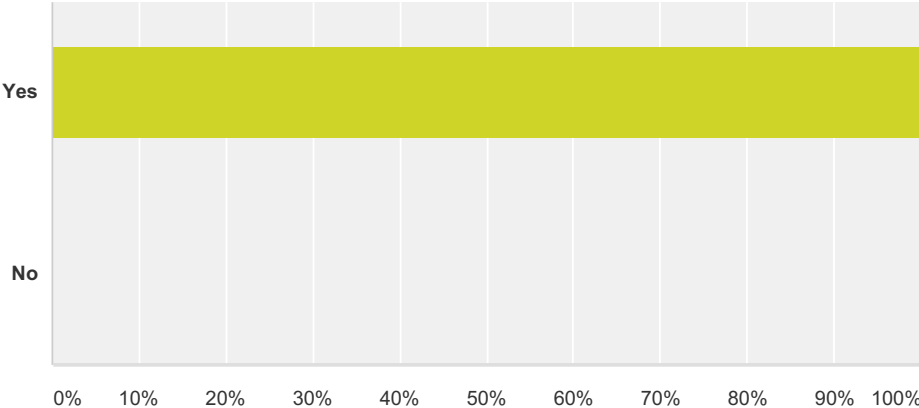


**Q1 Has your office rejected any documents notarized on or after Jan.1 because the notarial certificates did not comply with the requirements of SB 1050?**

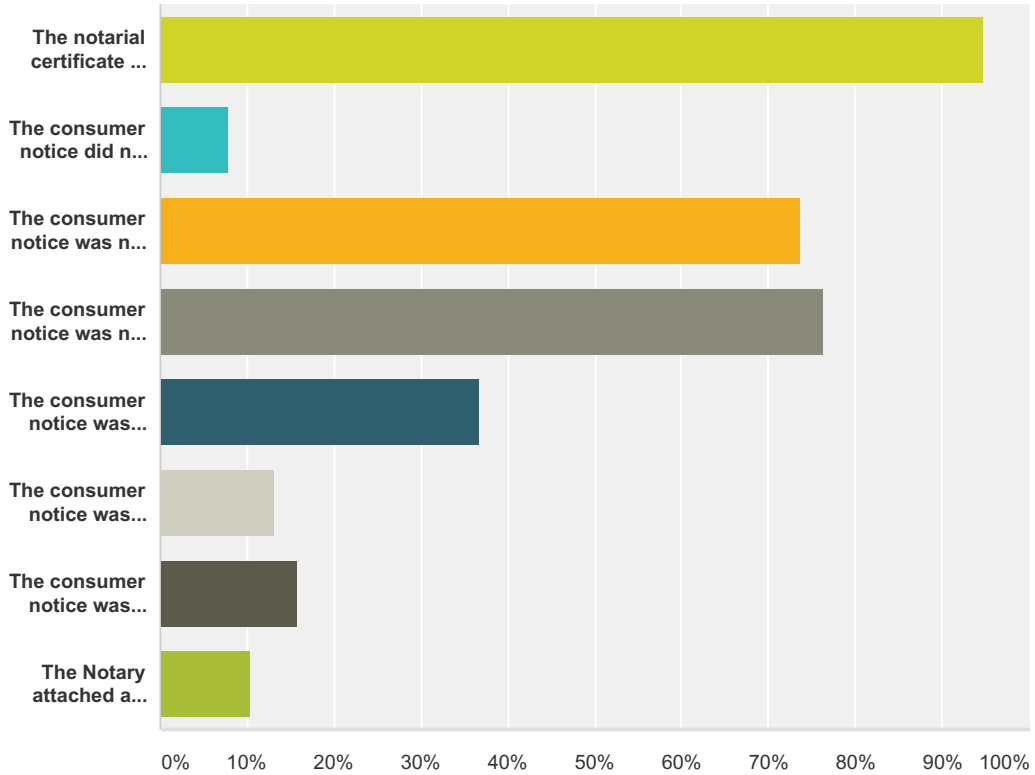
